## **MEXICAN PRIZE FOR SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY**

The *Premio Mexico de Ciencia y Tecnologia* (Mexican Prize for Science & Technology) was established on 27 February 1990 by the Presidency of the Republic to recognize the scientific and technological work produced by active researchers residing in one of the countries comprising the region of Ibero-america and the Caribbean, and to stimulate relations of their scientific and technological communities with those of Mexico.

The Mexican Government has issued an invitation to scientific and technological institutions of Central America, the Caribbean, Spain and Portugal to nominate candidates for the 2008 *Premio Mexico de Ciencia y tecnologia*. This year the prize consists of \$560,000.00 Mexican pesos, a medal and a diploma. The deadline for reception of the candidacies is **31 October 2008**.
