INSTRUCTIONS TO AUTHORS

ABSTRACT

The following format is required:

- ◇ Maximum length, 200 words
- ◇ Typewritten on A4 paper with margins as follows:
 - ⇒ Top margin 1 inch
 - ⇒ Bottom margin 1 inch
 - ⇒ Left margin 1 inch
 - ⇒ Right margin 1 inch
- ◇ Use font **Times New Roman**
- ◇ For Title, font size 13 pti, **bold** and align centre
- ◇ For Author(s) and Address(es), font size 11 pti and align centre
- ◇ For Text, font size 11 pti, single-spaced and fully justified.

Abstracts of about 200 words should be submitted by **September 9, 2010**.

FULL PAPER

The accepted Full Paper will be included in the Proceedings.

FORMAT

The Full Paper should be as follows:

- ◇ Maximum length 3-5 pages
- ◇ Typewritten on A4 paper with margins as follows:
 - ⇒ Top margin 1 inch
 - ⇒ Bottom margin 1 inch
 - ⇒ Left margin 1 inch
 - ⇒ Right margin 1 inch
- ◇ Use font **Times New Roman**
- ◇ For Title, font size 13 pti, **bold** and align centre

- ◇ For Author(s), font size 11 pti and aligned centre
- ◇ For Heading, font 12 pti and **bold**
- ◇ For Sub-heading, font size 11 pti, **bold** and *italic*
- ◇ For Text, font size 11 pti, single spaced and fully justified.
- ◇ Do not use Upper Case for the whole text
- ◇ Graphs/maps/figures should be camera-ready (ready for printing).

YOUNG SCIENTIST/ TECHNOLOGIST AWARD

CRITERIA FOR THE AWARD

This Award is presented biannually and will each year reflect the theme of the Conference on Science and Technology which for this year is **Green Technologies for Survival**

Nominations of suitably qualified persons are invited for the above award. Applications will also be accepted from the Principal Investigator or a group member of a Research and Development project with validation from a recognized research institution.

Eligibility

Jamaican young scientists/ technologists who are actively engaged in research relevant to Jamaica's development.

Non-nationals doing research relevant to Jamaica's development and residing in Jamaica for a minimum of ten (10) years.

Applicants must be forty (40) years old or less in the year of the award.

Selection Criteria

The winner will be selected based on the following criteria.

- 1) Outstanding creativity and innovation.
- 2) Applied research with commercial value
- 3) Potential for Jamaica's development
- 4) Peer-reviewed publications
- 5) Oral presentation at the Conference on Science & Technology, in the year of the award.

Nominations/applications should be submitted no later than **October 4, 2010**.
