TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Terms of Reference and Definitions

In these rules and Regulations the terms “Exhibitor“ shall include all owners, partners, directors, employees and agents of any company or individual to whom space has been allocated for the purpose of participating.

Exhibition Display

The Organizers reserve the right to modify the layouts of exhibition areas. The Organizers reserve the right to require exhibitors to make such alterations to their stalls or to the shifting of exhibits, as they reasonably feel necessary to maintain an acceptable standard of presentation or to avoid interference with sessions or displays of other exhibitors.

The Exhibitor is not permitted to lend, sublet or exchange booths with third party or another exhibitor. Exhibits shall be limited to the items that the Exhibitor trades or produces.

Exhibition Areas

Materials, posters & signage will not be allowed to be placed directly on walls or doors. The use of thumb tacks on walls is strictly prohibited. Exhibitors are required to compensate the Organizers against any claim made against them in respect of damage to the Exhibition area, booths and property caused by exhibitors, exhibits or staff, or by agents acting on behalf of an Exhibitor.

Exhibitors are required to keep their area clean. In the case where products are being sampled, adequate garage bins should be provided by the Exhibitor.

Flammable Materials

All materials used in the outfitting of booths and displays are to be fully fire-proofed and comply with all other local regulations.

Insurance & Liability

Exhibitors must make provision for safeguarding their materials, equipment and displays at all times. Exhibitors are advised to carry special insurance to cover exhibitor material against loss or damage and public liability insurance against injury to the person and property of others. Though the Conference will be provided with security, Exhibitors should not interpret this as a guarantee or indemnity against loss or theft of any kind. Each Exhibitor assumes the responsibility and liability for losses, damages and claims arising out of injury or damage.

Customs broker services

The Organizers are in the process of identifying a preferred customs broker to ensure ease of importation of your exhibition material. All costs associated with custom brokerage must be borne directly by the Exhibitors. Arrangement and payment for transporting goods to and from the Exhibition, and for receiving, and removal of exhibits are the responsibility of the Exhibitor. ■
